At the start of the 8th grade school year:

• Sacramental preparation registration form, which is attached to this document, is to be turned in during registration time in August.

Before the start of the 9th grade school year:

- Two short reflection papers on the required service projects.
- Choose a Confirmation sponsor and turn in required forms.

Before the completion of three-year program:

• Parent participation in the parish's "Belonging" sacramental preparation program.

Notes:

- Where *Family* is noted, all members of the confirmand's family are encouraged to participate together; at least one parent is required.
- <u>"Service Projects"</u> differ from accumulating service hours independently; they are done in community for the service of others. Several options will be provided each year to choose from. Examples include: Soups On Us meal

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preparation & delivery, Parish Cleanup Days, Arnold Towers Meal Program, Parish Mission Trip, Salvation Army Kettle Bell, Brass Band Festival Outreach, etc. Community-wide service projects are also accepted, and we encourage you to participate with other families and parishioners in those events. If there is a question about whether something is considered a "service project," please discuss it ahead of time with the Confirmation catechist (Brigette Becker).

Following each service project, the confirmand writes and turns in a short reflection paper covering the following topics: *Describe the service project you chose and why you chose it. How did you encounter Jesus in the Christian Service you provided? What did you learn about being a disciple of Jesus through the service you provided? How did you experience being a part of the Church family in the service project?*

- The one-day retreat will typically be scheduled in the Fall of the 8th grade year. It is designed for families and confirmandi to enter into the spiritual experience of preparing for Confirmation and begin to unpack the graces God is pouring out on us through prayer, the power of the Holy Spirit, and our call to be priest, prophet and king.
- "Belonging" Program: Once during the three years of preparation, parents of the confirmandi are required to participate in the parish's "Belonging" program as a "refresher" on the role of parents/families in the faith formation of their children. It is also an opportunity to reflect on the intimate connection among the sacraments of initiation, especially Baptism and Confirmation. The Renewal of the Baptismal Promises are a vital and beautiful part of the rite of Confirmation. (This requirement is also being extended to families with children preparing for First Communion. If you have participated in our parish's "Belonging" program in the past 3 years, please let Brigette know this will satisfy your requirement in that case.)
- Your Confirmation sponsor ought to be someone who you know and trust, and someone who lives and inspires you to live the Catholic faith. Your sponsor should also meet the qualifications listed on the Confirmation Sponsor Form. If you have any questions or need help finding a sponsor, then please ask.
- <u>Mass Participation:</u> Presence and participation in Sunday Mass and Holy Days of obligation (there are six: The Feast of Mary the Mother of God, The Ascension, The Assumption of Mary into Heaven, All Saints Day, The Feast

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of the Immaculate Conception, and Christmas) need to form the foundation of preparation for the sacrament of Confirmation. (This is an expectation for all Catholics, not just those preparing for Confirmation.)

• <u>Edge Participation</u>: Becoming an active, faithful part of the Edge discipleship community for middle schoolers is a key part of your youth's preparation to accept the gifts and responsibilities that come with Confirmation.
