Gladys Reed Gwinn Scholarship Foundation Guidelines

Eligibility:

Based upon Mrs. Gwinn's wishes, applicants must meet **at least** one of the following criteria (**in priority order**):

- Ss. Peter and Paul Catholic Church members attending a Catholic Women's College as an undergraduate student.
- Ss. Peter and Paul Catholic Church members attending college or postsecondary school as an undergraduate student.
- Boyle County resident attending college or post-secondary school as an undergraduate student.

Status of Applicant:

Applicant must be a graduating high school senior with evidence of post-secondary school admission or currently enrolled as an undergraduate student in a post-secondary school.

Award Selection:

Recipients will be selected using a combination of criteria:

- Post-Secondary School planning to enroll or currently enrolled. (Female applicants with enrollment in an all-women's Catholic School and applicants enrolled in a Catholic University will be given first priority.)
- ❖ Leadership potential church and community service, extracurricular activities, and/or athletic involvement.
- ❖ A personal essay (1-2 pages printed)
 - Remember, only you can tell your story. We discourage the use of Algenerated answers (ex. platforms such as ChatGPT).

Term of Scholarship:

The scholarship is for one academic year of post-secondary education. This scholarship is non-renewable; however, applicants may reapply each year enrolled as an undergraduate student in a post-secondary institution. Award money varies from year to year.
